- Practice writing tricky words- cursive writing only

- Continue to practice writing name daily in cursive writing only- please email me if you would like me to write out your daughter's name in cursive format.

# To answer some questions on how we usually approach writing letters in the classroom, I've written it out below (3)

• When practicing writing letters we usually demonstrate writing one big version of the letter using highlighter.

## In school we highlight:

- When drawing cursive letters, the pen/pencil does not lift off the page for the duration of the letter being written.
- All cursive letters begin with a diagonal line, in an upwards motion, starting on the line that the letter is being written.
- Discuss the letter- 'What other letters or shapes can you see in this letter?' I will attach a PDF to the class page highlighting the connections children often make

between letters. This gives children confidence learning to write a new letter when they feel that they already know how to write part of the letter.

- The next step would then be for your daughter to trace bigger version of the highlighted letter written by an adult in multiple colours. This is called rainbow channelling only changing colours after successfully tracing the full letter.
- Trace smaller highlighted letters
- Write letters free-handed while looking at video of letter being written/looking at sample letter already written
- Look, cover, write, check: Look at the sample letter, cover it, write it, check it.
- Finally: Write letter in response to the letters name/ sound, without looking at any sample. (This is practiced all through Senior Infants too, so don't worry if the girls aren't at this point yet.)
