We have had coaches from Leinster Rugby delivering these sessions for a few years now and it is always a very popular activity. We hope the girls really enjoy it.

The girls in 3<sup>rd</sup> class will begin 6 weeks of **recorder lessons** next week with a teacher from the **Artane School of Music**. This is a really wonderful opportunity for them. Throughout the 6 weeks, the girls will be introduced to the basic fundamentals of music and they will learn 2-3 tunes on their recorder.
